



## Yirrganydji Land and Sea Ranger Program Senior Ranger

**LOCATION:** Cairns, Far North Queensland

The Yirrganydji Land and Sea Ranger Program was established in 2015 by Dawul Wuru Aboriginal Corporation to support Yirrganydji community-based conservation, land and sea management, enhancing the social, cultural, and economic wellbeing of Yirrganydji people, and contributing to environmental and heritage outcomes for the wider Cairns region in North Queensland, Australia.

**This Position**, Senior Ranger, is responsible for performing a lead role in implementing and supervising the Yirrganydji Land and Sea Ranger team, program, and operations. This position has a strong focus on supporting and mentoring rangers to maximise their participation in natural and cultural resource management activities and delivering practical and operational tasks of the Yirrganydji Land and Sea Ranger Program. This position will also support the aspirations and priorities of Dawul Wuru Aboriginal Corporation and Yirrganydji community.

**Applicants** should possess sound knowledge of Aboriginal caring for country & land and sea management principles in a changing environment and have demonstrated ability to manage practical and operational activities, and effectively manage and lead work teams.

**Skills set** includes experience in a similar role with government, industry, or community sector. Good communications, negotiation and report writing skills, with tertiary qualifications or experience in environmental management or related discipline desirable, and possessing both a manual drivers licence and Coxswains certification is essential.

Being a Traditional Owner from the Yirrganydji Region is a genuine occupational qualification for this role under *Section 25 of the QLD Anti-Discrimination Act 1991*. To perform this role, Traditional owners from the Yirrganydji region are strongly encouraged to apply.
